Storytelling: A person who narrates stories.

In this fun-filled activity, children narrate the story as this three word picture book is shared.

MATERIALS NEEDED:

- ❖ Four Tin Cans covered in colored contact paper -they should fit one inside the other and glue a picture of one of the characters on each can.
- ❖ Three Tin Cans covered in colored contact paper -they should fit one inside the other and glue on a card with each of the three words from the story.

ACTIVITY:

On each page of the story have the children tell you what they see, how does the monkey feel and what do you think he wants? As you get to each animal in the story, pull his can out of the other cans. As you get to the three different words in the story, pull them out of their can as well. This activity can be designed in any manner you choose, the children will enjoy retelling, sequencing and finding the animals that match each page of the story. The best way to create storytellers is to give them a voice and wordless picture books.
