Estimated number of African American Kansans as of July 1, 2009. This is 6.2% of the state's population. African Americans account for 12.9% of the total U.S. population.

48,333

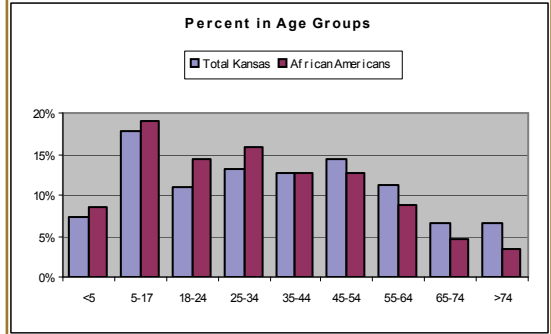
There are 48,333 more African Americans in Kansas today than in 1980. That is a 38.3% increase, compared to a 19.3% increase in the total number of Kansans during that period.

213,700

The projected African American population in Kansas in 2030, according to Woods and Poole Economics, Inc.

3,192

The number of African Americans in Kansas who serve in the armed forces. This is 2.7% of those over the age of 16, compared with 0.8% for the total Kansas population. There are 13,153 African American veterans living in Kansas.

The percent of the African American population under age 18, compared to 24.9% of the general Kansas population.

29.7

The median age of the African Americans in Kansas. 35.9 years is the median age for all Kansans, and 36.8 for the United States.

The number of African American Kansans over 65 years of age, 60.4% of whom are women.

5,647

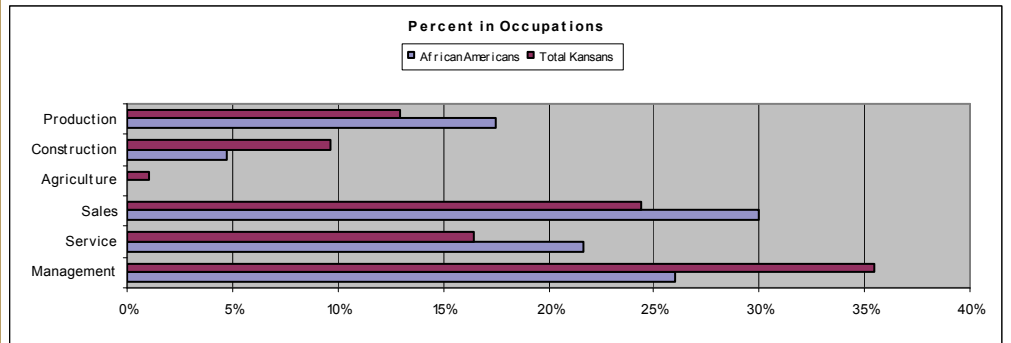
