Flannel Board Fun – A Hiding Game



Preparation:

Using felt, make a chicken and several sofas of different colors similar to the ones above.

Play:

Put each sofa on the board, and tell the kids chicken is going to hide behind one of them.

Turn the board around and have kids close their eyes.

Slip chicken under one of the sofas.

Turn the board back around and have the kids open their eyes.

Have them take turns guessing which sofa. With each guess, we sing a song or chant, "Let's all look! Let's all look! Behind the (color) sofa!" It builds suspense and the kids cheer and clap when chicken is found.
