



Kansas librarians sign up to be readers and answer an interest level survey to create a “reading profile.”



Kansas authors upload self-published titles.



Library Journal checks the uploaded title to be sure it’s in compliance with ebook technical standards.



If the ebook passes, the title becomes immediately available to Kansas residents through an online platform.



The State Library will then assign the approved ebooks to our librarian readers based on reader profiles from the interest level survey.

At the same time, Library Journal will review books to be added to their “select” titles.



All titles will remain on the statewide platform. Some titles will be elevated to a “Kansas Librarian Recommended” level and/or “Library Journal Select” level. Kansas readers can also read and review titles.
