Digital Audiobooks: books you listen to on a computer, mobile device, or MP3 player.

	RBdigital (formerly OneClickdigital)
What is available?	Mostly fiction and some popular nonfiction. Most titles are on a traditional library model (library buys copies, if all copies are checked out place a hold). Some titles have unlimited copies, like the Modern Scholar lectures and many classics.
How do I use this?	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Registration Step: login to the Kansas Library eCard (http://kslc.org) and choose the OneClickdigital Registration link. Create your account, choosing you own username and password (one time only, if you have lost your login contact us). 2. Install the OneClick computer software or mobile app. Sign in to it with your username/password. 3. Use the Browse Website link in the software or Search feature in the app to checkout a book. 4. Return to the software or main screen of the app to use the book.

Transfer: iPods only.
No software use options?	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Listen Online (streaming) – works for ChromeBooks, Windows phone, and other devices without a software/app version. • Manual Download (download book files direct)-works well for computers too old to use software.
Lending periods?	Check out a book for up to 21 days. Renewals available if no holds list. 10 checkouts per patron maximum. Early return available.

Youth Materials: unlimited use of each title, no actual checkout, no software required.

	BookFlix (Scholastic)	Britannica E-STAX
What is it?	Animated storybooks paired with a nonfiction ebook. Some puzzles.	Nonfiction ebooks, now includes materials for grade 6 & above.
How do I use this?	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Click the BookFlix link. • Browse through subjects, and click on a book pair to select it. • Click on either the storybook to watch it or the ebook to read. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Click the E-STAX link. • Browse or search to select a book. • Read Online opens the book to be read in your browser. Optional download of book to software/ mobile app.
Anything else I need to know?	Public libraries can use direct link, or be set up for local stats access. No curriculum use of this product.	School & public libraries can ask for a direct link, or setup for special in-house access. No restrictions on school use.

What are the lending periods & limits?	Checkout for 14 days, no renewal option. 5 checkouts per patron. Early return available.	Checkout for 21 days, no renewal option. 10 checkouts per patron. Early return available.	Checkout for 14 days. Each account has 5 checkouts/ week; unused ones roll over for 4 weeks.	Checkouts do not expire, can continue re-reading a book at any point. No limits at this time.
