RBdigital

1. Register for an account:
 - a. Log in at <http://www.kslc.org>
 - b. Select the RBdigital registration link.
 - c. Fill out the registration form, creating your own username & password. This is one-time only.
2. Install the RBdigital software or mobile app.
3. Log in to it with your username & password. Choose library name State Library of Kansas if needed.
4. Find a book to check out:
 - a. Mobile app: tap the magnifying glass in right corner, then audiobooks, to see search/browse options.
 - b. Software: click the “browse for a title.”
5. Listen to the book:
 - a. Mobile app: select the menu (3 line button) & go to Checked Out.
 - b. Software: go back to the software, click the refresh button. Computer software can transfer to compatible MP3 players.

Notes about RBdigital

- Traditional book checkout—place a hold if all copies are checked out!
- Checkout period up to 21 days.
- Early return, renewal available (if no holds).

Youth Materials

- All online—no software required, works on computers & mobile.
- No limits on how many books you can use.

BookFix

video storybooks paired with a related ebook, some games.

Britannica E-STAX

nonfiction ebooks, PreK-grade 9 reading level books.

Note: the other systems have juvenile books, but also contain adult materials. These two only have youth books.

eBooks

books you read on screen, multiple options

What's the difference

between these options?

- Cloud Library—books from larger publishers, mostly fiction.
- Freeding—high variety fiction & nonfiction (over 70K books). No holds.
- Enki—variety of fiction & nonfiction including independent authors (over 60K books)
- Total Boox (mobile app only) - variety of fiction/nonfiction (over 70K), checkouts do not expire, includes Elsevier Science books.

Can I use them all if I want?

Yes, though you might end up with a favorite!

Cloud Library

- Traditional checkout type—place a hold if all copies of a book are checked out.
- Books check out for 14 days, early return available. No renewal, but your place in the book is saved when you check out the book again!
- Install the Cloud Library software or mobile app, or click the website to use the Online Reader
- Log in to the software/app: Library Card ID = Kansas Library eCard number
- PIN = birthdate in MMDDYYYY format. Browse, search and check out books inside the software/app.
- Go to the My Books section to read the book. Computer software allows transfer to most ereaders.

Freeding or Enki

- Install free software/app—they can use the same one, and create an Adobe ID.
- Log in to Freeding or Enki site with your Kansas Library eCard (PIN is birthdate in MMDDYYYY format).
- Browse, search, & check out books.
- Click the download option for the book. Choose to open when prompted by your browser.
- Read the book in the software/app. Computer software allows transfer to most ereaders.

Freeding

- Unlimited copies of each book, you use a weekly allowance to check out.
- Checkout period is 14 days. Renewal available.

Enki

<http://kslenkilibrary.org>

- Checkout period is 21 days. Early return. Traditional checkout.
- Online Reader (ChromeBook option) accessible from My Account screen.

Total Boox

- Unlimited copies of each book, and checkouts do not expire.
- Mobile only—iPad/iPhone, Android, or Kindle Fire devices.
- Install “Total Boox for Libraries” app. Login with your Kansas Library eCard.
- Tap the Get Books button to browse & check out books inside the app.
- Return to the My Library screen to read.
