### Digital Audiobooks: books you listen to on a computer, mobile device, or MP3 player.

	<b>RBdigital (formerly OneClickdigital)</b>
<b>What is available?</b>	Mostly fiction and some popular nonfiction. Most titles are on a traditional library model (library buys copies, if all copies are checked out place a hold). Some titles have unlimited copies, like the Modern Scholar lectures and many classics.
<b>How do I use this?</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Registration Step: login to the Kansas Library eCard (<a href="http://kslc.org">http://kslc.org</a>) and choose the RBdigital Registration link. Create your account, choosing you own username and password (one time only, if you have lost your login contact us).</li> <li>2. Install the RBdigital mobile app. Sign in to it with your username/password.</li> <li>3. Use the Browse Website link in the software or Search feature in the app to checkout a book.</li> <li>4. Return to the software or main screen of the app to use the book.</li> </ol>
<b>Apps &amp; Software</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• iPad / iPhone / iPod Touch</li> <li>• Android devices &amp; Nook Tablets; Android version</li> <li>• Kindle Fires</li> <li>• Windows Vista, 7, 8, and 10 (includes full Windows tablets, like the Surface Pro) Transfer to MP3: only iPods are fully compatible; partial compatibility with all other MP3 players, see <a href="http://kslib.info/130">http://kslib.info/130</a></li> <li>• Mac OSX 10.7 and newer. Transfer: iPods only.</li> </ul>
<b>No software use options?</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Listen Online (streaming) – works for ChromeBooks, Windows phone, and other devices without a software/app version.</li> <li>• Manual Download (download book files direct)-works well for computers too old to use software.</li> </ul>
<b>Lending periods?</b>	Check out a book for up to 21 days. Renewals available if no holds list. 10 checkouts per patron maximum. Early return available.

### Youth Materials: unlimited use of each title, no actual checkout, no software required.

	<b>BookFlix (Scholastic)</b>	<b>Britannica E-STAX</b>
<b>What is it?</b>	Animated storybooks paired with a nonfiction eBook. Some puzzles.	Nonfiction eBooks, now includes materials for grade 6 & above.
<b>How do I use this?</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Click the BookFlix link.</li> <li>• Browse through subjects, and click on a book pair to select it.</li> <li>• Click on either the storybook to watch it or the eBook to read.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Click the E-STAX link.</li> <li>• Browse or search to select a book.</li> <li>• Read Online opens the book to be read in your browser. Optional download of book to software/ mobile app.</li> </ul>
<b>Anything else I need to know?</b>	Public libraries can use direct link, or be set up for local stats access. <b>No curriculum use of this product.</b>	School & public libraries can ask for a direct link, or setup for special in-house access. No restrictions on school use.

	<b>cloudLibrary</b>	<b>Enki</b>	<b>Freeding</b>
<b>What is the difference?</b>	Traditional library model. Bestsellers and larger publishers. Mostly fiction. (Formerly 3M)	Traditional library model & independent publishers; wide variety of fiction & nonfiction. Study guides, graphic novels.	Unlimited copies of each book. Small & medium publishers, wide variety of fiction/nonfiction.
<b>How do I use this?</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Install the cloudLibrary software or mobile app.</li> <li>2. Log in the software/app with your Kansas Library eCard.</li> <li>3. Browse or search for a book INSIDE the software, check it out there.</li> <li>4. Use the book from in the My Books area of software/app.</li> </ol>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Install reader software or mobile app.</li> <li>2. Click the link to the Enki site &amp; login with your Kansas Library eCard.</li> <li>3. Check out a book, download it into your software/app.</li> <li>4. Use the book in the software/app.</li> </ol>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Install reader software or mobile app.</li> <li>2. Click the link to the Freeding site &amp; login with your Kansas Library eCard.</li> <li>3. Select a book, use the “Download” link.</li> <li>4. Use the book in the software/app.</li> </ol>

<b>What are the lending periods &amp; limits?</b>	Checkout for 14 days, no renewal option. 5 checkouts at a time. Early return available.	Checkout for 21 days, no renewal option. 10 checkouts per patron. Early return available.	Checkout for 14 days. Each account has 5 checkouts/ week; unused ones roll over for 4 weeks.
<b>Anything else I need to know?</b>	All functions are INSIDE the software or app. Website has the read online option.	Librarian-created system, so it looks like library catalog.	We are not charged for unused checkouts on patron accounts.
