Eligibility of Blind and Other Physically Handicapped Persons for Loan of Library Materials

The following persons are eligible for loan services:

1. Legally blind persons.
2. Other print disabled persons as follows:
 - a. Persons whose visual disability, with correction, prevents the reading of standard printed material.
 - b. Persons unable to read or unable to use standard printed materials as a result of physical limitations.
 - c. Persons having a reading disability resulting from organic dysfunction and of sufficient severity to prevent their reading printed material in a normal manner.

Certifying Authority

Eligibility must be certified by one of the following:

Doctor of medicine, doctor of osteopathy, ophthalmologist, optometrist, psychologist, registered nurse, therapist, and professional staff of hospitals, institutions, and public or welfare agencies (such as an educator, a social worker, case worker, counselor, rehabilitation teacher, certified reading specialist, school psychologist, superintendent, or librarian).

Network libraries may accept scanned signatures of certifying authorities in lieu of hard-copy originals. The requirement to retain a signed/certified copy of the application remains. The copy may be retained in paper files or properly organized, secure, and retrievable electronic files.

Qualified readers must be residents of the United States, including territories, and the District of Columbia, or American citizens domiciled abroad.

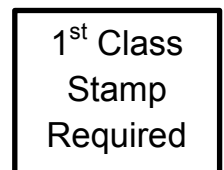
Return of Equipment

Playback equipment and special attachments are supplied to eligible persons on extended loan. If the loaned equipment is not being used in conjunction with recorded reading material provided by the Library of Congress, it must be returned to the loaning library. Funding provided by the State Library of Kansas through a grant from the U.S. Institute of Museum and Library Services.

BARD (Braille and Audio Reading Download)

BARD is a free service available to Kansas Talking Books patrons that enables users to download digital audio and/or braille books or magazines:

- from the website for use with digital talking book machine, or
- to a personal mobile device using the BARD Mobile app.



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
